Introduction of Risk Assessment of schools: As mentioned previously schools who were good or outstanding in their last Section 48 Inspection will be monitored via a review of their documentation after three years. This will start in the summer term 2015 with schools being notified in the spring term. Schools who were last inspected prior to Jan 2012 will not be part of this (unless requested or where there is cause for concern). Schools last inspected between Jan-Dec 2012 will be first.

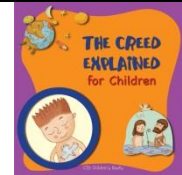
